RESPONSIBILITY & RELEASE

Getaway Weekend Vacations, Inc., the tour operator trading as Adventure Unlimited® is hereinafter referred to as ADVENTURE within this document. ADVENTURE hereby gives notice that ADVENTURE does not own or operate any motor coaches, cruise lines, aircraft, catering facilities, hotels or attractions and that all arrangements have been made with hotels, motor coach companies, and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services purchased in the tour upon the express condition that we shall not be liable for any injury, accident, loss, damage, delay, bankruptcy, or any irregularity which may occur either by reason of defect in any vehicle or through the acts of default of any person or company engaged in providing transportation or other services. ADVENTURE does not accept any liability for the actions or omissions of these independent suppliers over whom ADVENTURE has no direct control. In the absence of negligence on ADVENTURE's part, therefore EACH PARTICIPANT HEREBY RELEASES ADVENTURE for losses or damages arising from physical or emotional injury, property damages, or other economic damage caused by such factors beyond ADVENTURE's control. Because of unforeseen circumstances, ADVENTURE reserves the right to withdraw any tour or make any change, with or without notice. In the event of inclement weather, mechanical difficulties, or other events beyond the control of ADVENTURE that cause delays, it SHALL NOT BE the responsibility of ADVENTURE to pay for resulting costs and expenses to the group, including additional lodging and meals. Furthermore, it SHALL NOT BE the responsibility of ADVENTURE to reimburse the group for tour inclusions missed resulting from such delay.

Optional activities are offered as advertised unless weather or other conditions make it impossible for individuals to participate. Payment for optional activities must be made in cash at the location. ADVENTURE assumes no risk, liability, or responsibility for incidents or accidents which may occur to an individual while participating in any activity. Many activities are subject to a minimum participation as dictated by the operator and available transportation. Prices for all optional activities are subject to change with or without notice. Upon request, ADVENTURE will provide hotel and other brochures to the Group Organizer. Also, ADVENTURE provides links to each hotels website on ADVENTURE's website, www.adventureunlimited.com.

It is the responsibility of the Group Organizer to assure that each group member receives the proper "Statement of Responsibilities, Release, Terms and Conditions" and other policies as represented by ADVENTURE. "Statement of Responsibilities, Release, Terms and Conditions" for tour participants are printed on the back of flyers printed by ADVENTURE, available on-line ([www.adventureunlimited.com/organizer/support/download/center/Tour Conditions & Policies/Statement of Responsibility, Release, Terms and Conditions for Adult Winter Tours](http://www.adventureunlimited.com/organizer/support/download/center/Tour%20Conditions%20&%20Policies/Statement%20of%20Responsibility,Release,Terms%20and%20Conditions%20for%20Adult%20Winter%20Tours)). We will also gladly provide free copies to distribute.

The Group Organizer acts solely as a representative of the group and is NOT an employee, representative or agent of ADVENTURE. This tour is governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State Of New Jersey. In the unlikely event a dispute cannot be amicably resolved and a court action is necessary, it is agreed that all disputes and demands shall be heard in Camden County, NJ.

RESERVATIONS, PAYMENTS, CONFIRMATIONS & PRICING

The Group Organizer has the obligation of sending names and money in accordance with the terms of the Group Tour Agreement. Collection and disbursement of all group funds, and all communication with Adventure is solely the Group Organizer's responsibility. All conversations and arrangements regarding the tour are conducted through the Group Organizer and Adventure. Also, conversations with employees or agents of Adventure concerning, among other things, time and space reserved cannot be assumed, unless confirmed in writing by Adventure.

Space is held for requested reservations upon the timely receipt of deposits and names at Adventure. Final arrangements and confirmations are made for requested reservations upon receipt of the complete rooming list and final group payment at Adventure. Whenever the Group Organizer has complied with providing Adventure the payments and rooming lists as per the dates on the GTA, and in the unlikely event Adventure can not provide the contracted destination, Adventure will provide a full refund as its only liability. In the absence of either the arrival of the rooming list or final payment in full as per the dates on the GTA, the space held is released and the group is placed on a space available basis. If tour arrangements at the contracted destination can not be made when the payment balance and rooming lists arrive at Adventure, the group may be subject to cancellation unless the Group Organizer selects an available alternate tour operated by Adventure. In this case, the money in the group's account will then be applied to the new tour. If the group rejects the alternate destination and opts to cancel the tour, the group balance payment, less the cancellation fees specified in the provision "CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS", will be returned as ADVENTURE'S only liability. The remaining funds in the account are forfeited as liquidated damages. There is a \$35 charge for each returned check.

SKI EQUIPMENT

Each hotel ski shop operated by Lease-A-Ski corporation offers ski systems featuring step-in-binding with ski brakes. These shops carry an extensive, but not exhaustive, inventory of adult ski and boot sizes. Individuals whose shoe requirement is other than standard, or requiring sizes smaller than adult size 5 or larger than adult size 13, must make other arrangements (either prior to departure or at the ski area). Ski rental rates are quoted and guaranteed for equipment rented from a Lease-A-Ski Corporation rental shop located within the hotel only. Each renter must sign a Rental Agreement prior to taking possession of the equipment. ADVENTURE is not responsible for any cost incurred should any ADVENTURE patron not fall within these size ranges or if there is not a sufficient quantity to meet the needs of all patrons. Arrangements for ski equipment rented elsewhere must be made and paid for by the renter.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

If a replacement is provided, there is no cancellation or processing fee. A replacement for a cancelled party must occupy the specific room space, include all activities and bus space the canceling party vacates (if bus transportation is included as part of the tour). Otherwise, if a reservation is cancelled for an individual, or group, the right to receive a refund is limited. Cancellations received more than 10 days prior to trip departure are subject to a processing fee of \$65 per person. If a replacement is not provided, the remaining occupants in the room shall be obligated to pay for their room upgrade. Cancellations received within 10 days prior to trip departure are subject to a cancellation fee of 100% of the published tour price. Notification of cancellation must be sent in writing by the Group Organizer, and shall be effective the date received in writing at ADVENTURE.

REFUNDS ARE MADE ON THE SPECIFIC CONDITION THAT THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE REFUND BY THE GROUP ORGANIZER ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE GROUP THEREBY RELEASES ADVENTURE FROM ALL CLAIMS THAT EITHER THE GROUP AS A WHOLE, OR INDIVIDUAL PARTICIPANTS IN THE GROUP SHALL OR MAY HAVE, AND ARE CONSIDERED FINAL. In the event of inclement weather or any Act of God, which causes a danger to the transportation of passengers to the destination, ADVENTURE will reschedule the winter weekend. REFUNDS OR ALLOWANCES WILL NOT BE MADE for portions of the tour that are unused for any reason whatsoever or for trips rescheduled due to Acts of God. The destination hotels and transportation companies, in addition to all other providers of services, reserve the right to remove individuals or an entire group from the tour without a refund if persons within the group are engaged in illegal or disorderly conduct.

BAGGAGE, TRIP CANCELLATION & OTHER INSURANCE

Free space is provided on each bus for the storage of personal belongings and baggage during transportation. The safekeeping of baggage and personal belongings is solely each participant's responsibility. Upon request, ADVENTURE will gladly provide information and rates for insurance. Insurance must be purchased no later than 21 days prior to departure.

TRANSPORTATION

Whenever the tour includes motor coach transportation, the published tour prices are based upon the group providing a minimum of 54 passengers per motor coach. If the group has less than the 54 minimum they are required to pay an "empty seat surcharge" for the unsold seats below the 54 minimum. ADVENTURE will provide the price of the empty seat surcharge for the particular destination upon request. If the Group Organizer desires, ADVENTURE will try to help the Group avoid incurring an empty seat surcharge by attempting to add passengers. No less than 21 days prior to departure, ADVENTURE requires written authorization from the Group Organizer requesting ADVENTURE's assistance to add passengers. Please note that this is not a guarantee that ADVENTURE will be successful. Adding passengers generally results in adding other pick-up locations.

Each group organizer assembles their own group and therefore, ADVENTURE is not able to screen individual participants. Therefore, ADVENTURE is not responsible for any situations that arise as a result of disagreements between individuals traveling on the same bus. Whenever a group requests to be combined with another group to assist them in filling their bus, their pick-up times will change. Estimated pick-up times are available for confirmation by the Group Organizer 24 hours prior to departure.

ADVENTURE is not responsible for any costs or damages sustained resulting from the group's selection of pick-up location. Selected pick-up locations are accommodated for those groups that are paid in full and consist of a minimum of 23 passengers. Groups with less than 23 passengers may be required to meet at an alternate location. All pick-up times are, at best, estimates due to the myriad of unforeseen circumstances such as; traffic, weather and road construction. Rates quoted are based upon tariffs current at the time of printing and are subject to changes therein at or before final payment. Changes in pick-up location and/or changes or delays in pick-up times and/or the adding of a fuel surcharge are not grounds for cancellation by the group or for any form of reimbursement.

LEGAL AGE TO PARTICIPATE ON THE TOUR

There is no minimum age to participate in the tours as advertised. Individuals must be a minimum of 21 years old to participate in functions containing alcoholic beverages. Individuals under 18 years of age, who are not accompanied by their parents or legal guardian, are required to provide to their Group Organizer/Trip Sponsor a "Youth Participation Application" signed by their parent or legal guardian. Participants will be cancelled and lose their payments if they do not provide a signed Application prior to departure. Applications are available from the Group Organizer/Trip Sponsor.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The hotel's front desk personnel make the room assignments and, based upon availability, they will attempt to fulfill requests for single or double-bedded and smoking or non-smoking rooms as submitted by the Group Organizer. Sometimes the number of two bedded and smoking rooms are limited therefore, rooming requests are handled on a first come first served basis. Per person prices are stipulated for the number of people in a room, not the number of beds. Double accommodations (2 people per room) does not necessarily mean that the room contains two beds. Rooms do not have more than 2 beds. Requests for roll-a-way beds or cots will result in additional cost to the occupants of the room.
