This panoramic eight-day sojourn which has been designed for bird shooters, plains game hunters and non-hunters commences in Pretoria. The train initially winds its way westwards en route to Mafeking where we overnight and prepare for our first shoot and off-train excursion. Then its southwards to Warrenton and Kimberley. Shooting takes place on day two, three and four with a day's break at Kimberley to relax and enjoy the atmosphere of this historic town. We then travel eastwards to Bloemfontein for an exciting day in this land of sunflower and maize. On day eight our train ambles slowly into Pretoria and an end to this remarkable fourteen hundred kilometre safari.

The afternoon brings ideal conditions for Egyptian Geese, Spur-winged Geese (seasonal), South African Shelduck and White-faced and Yellow-billed Duck (seasonal) as well as Red-billed Teal. Lunch in the field. <i>Typical animals encountered are</i> <i>Springbok, Blesbok, Impala, Warthog,</i> <i>Wildebeest, Kudu, Red Hartebeest</i> <i>and Eland.</i> *	DAY 4	Visit places of interest covering the Anglo Boer War. Lunch at Butlers Restaurant at The Estate Hotel. Visit William Humphreys Art Gallery. An optional game drive is available at the Timkulu Reserve, (a 30-minute drive from the train).
